

Attendance Update

In the 'Working Together to Improve School Attendance' document from Aug 2024, the Department for Education have introduced 'Sickness returns'.

From September 2024 schools have a duty to inform the LA of any child who is recorded as ill and who the school has reasonable grounds to believe will miss 15 days consecutively or cumulatively because of sickness.

This is for your information only and to let you know that as a school, we do have a legal duty to report on illness to the local authority.

Attendance Reporting

You can report an absence before 8:30am, by either:

- Phoning the school office 01952 388088
- Leaving a WhatsApp message on 07773130159

These methods are for your convenience and so that you don't have to come to the office to report illness. Please give a reason for the absence (including symptoms) if your child is ill. If we need further information, we will contact you.

There are two registration sessions in a school day so if your child feels better you can send them in later—every lesson counts!


- Children whose direct family are in the armed forces
