- Defibrillator Awareness

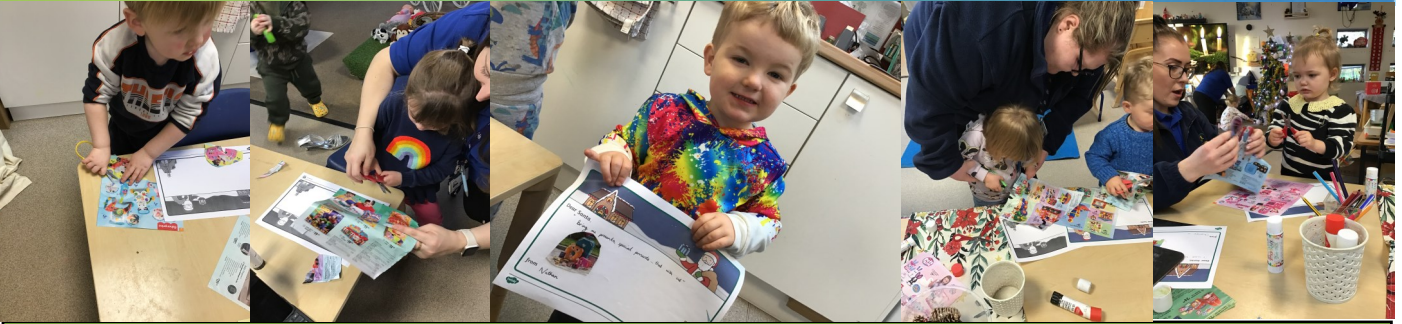
