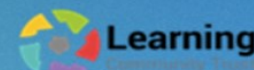

Today we held our first whole school event of the year – our Macmillan coffee morning. Thanks to your generosity, we raised an amazing £519.76. A huge thank you to our Year 6 pupils and staff for leading the event so positively, and to all of our parents who supported – whether by attending in person or by sending in cakes and biscuits. Your contributions made a real difference.

National Teaching Assistant Day

Today is also National Teaching Assistant Day. At Wrekin View, our learning support practitioners are a vital part of our school. They provide patience, encouragement, and expertise every single day – from supporting individual needs to celebrating the little steps of progress that make such a big difference. Our children flourish because of their care and commitment, and we are truly grateful for everything they do.

Harvest collection

This year we're going to do our Harvest collection a little differently. As we no longer have the community fridge here at Wrekin View, we'd like to be able to support families more directly when they need it. Our plan is to collect small amounts of money and use it to buy supermarket vouchers that we can keep in school for times when they're needed most. Good Afternoon

At Wrekin View Primary School, we are committed to ensuring every child receives the best possible education. When a child is absent, it's essential that parents or carers inform the school as soon as possible, ideally on the first day of absence.

If an absence is not reported, we are required to mark it as *unauthorised*. Unauthorised absences can have consequences. Not only do they affect your child's attendance record, but they may also lead to further action, including the possibility of a *fixed penalty notice* (fine) issued by the local authority.

Help your child with additional funding through Pupil Premium

Pupil Premium is extra funding for our school to support children who:

- Qualify for Free School Meals (FSM),
- Are in care or have been adopted,
- Have a parent in the armed forces.

This funding helps us provide extra learning support, wellbeing resources, and enrichment opportunities.

Even if your child doesn't want a free meal, applying helps the school access more support for all pupils.

If your child is in Reception, Year 1, or Year 2, they already get free meals but you still need to apply to unlock Pupil Premium funding.

You may qualify if you receive:

- Universal Credit (income under £7,400/year),
- Income Support or Jobseeker's Allowance,
- Child Tax Credit (without Working Tax Credit, income under £16,190),
- Pension Credit (Guarantee Credit),
- Support under the Immigration and Asylum Act.

Apply online or contact the school office for a form.

BBC 500 WORDS

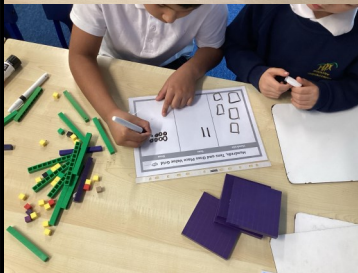
THE COMPETITION IS NOW OPEN!

We love our Learning



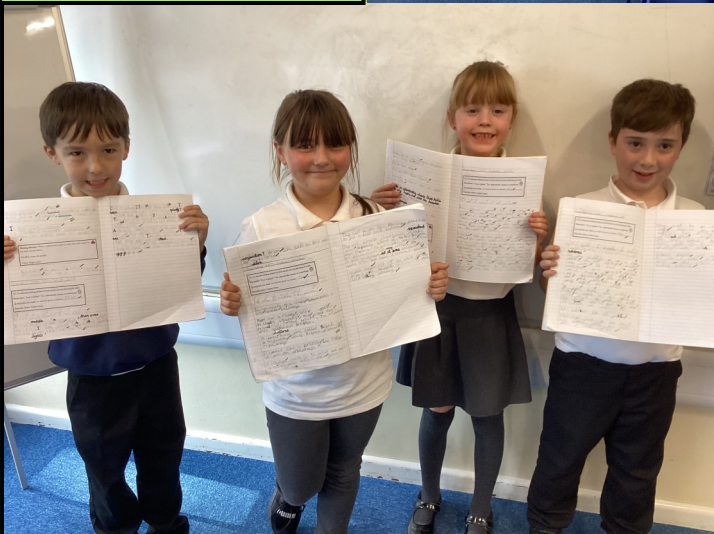
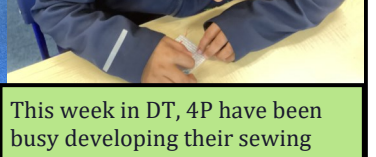
3A have been busy learning how to add pairs of 3 digit numbers using maths apparatus. Great teamwork and focus being shown.
