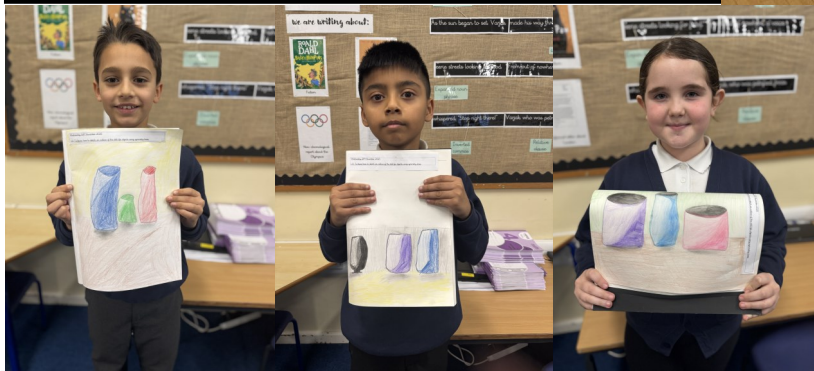


# We love our Learning

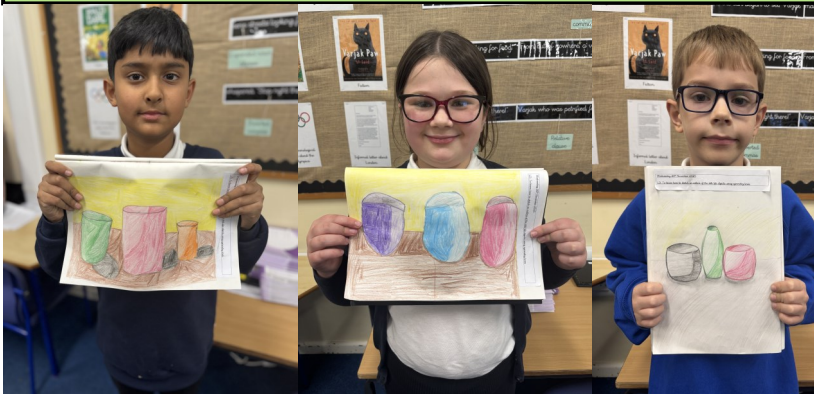


Some of our children attended a Christmas dance day earlier this week, run by Grace Birch. The children behaved so well and there was so much talent shown by everyone in the room. Well done all!
